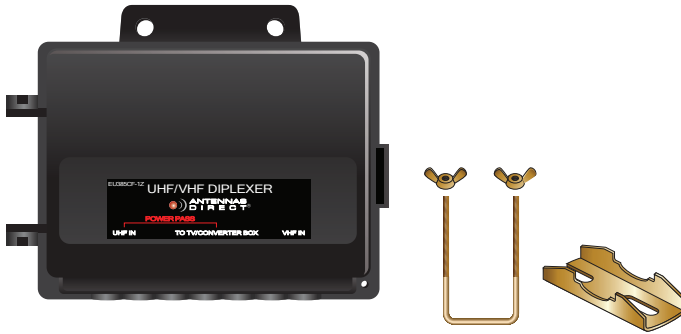


# Quick Start Assembly/Installation Instructions

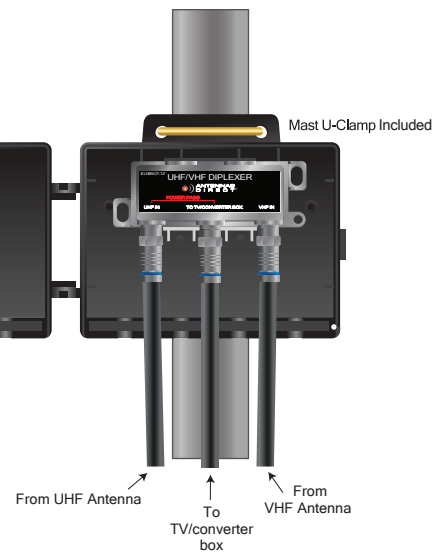
## UHF / VHF ANTENNA COMBINER

Coaxial Cable Not Included

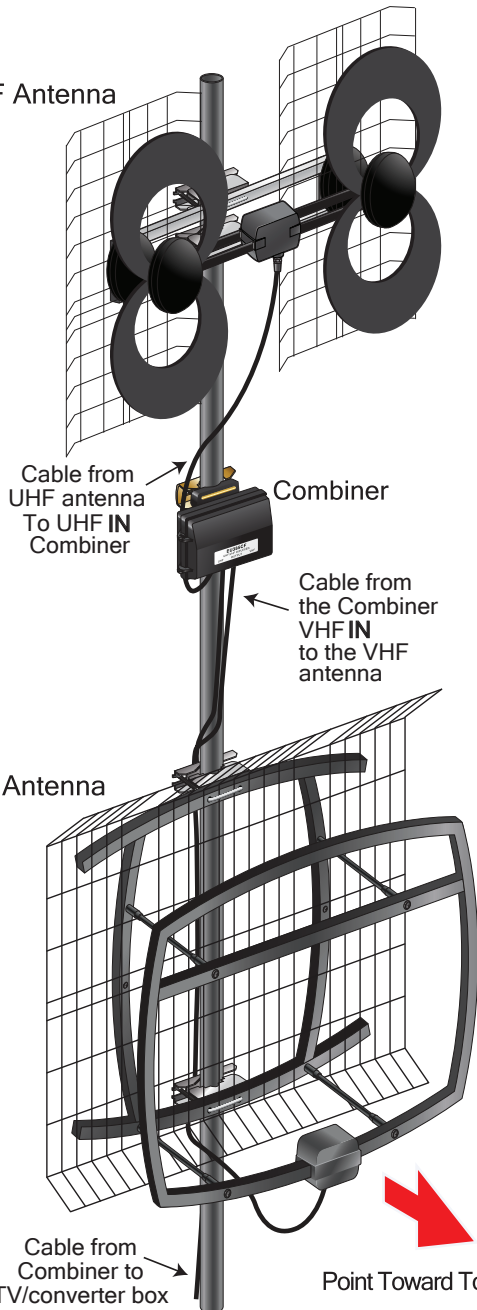
Combiner with Mounting Hardware

UHF Antenna



- 1) Install the antennas on a single mast with a minimum of 18 inches (3 feet is preferred) between the two antennas.
- 2) Run a short coaxial cable from the UHF Antenna to the combiner connector labeled UHF IN.
- 3) Repeat step 2, running a short coaxial cable from the VHF Antenna to the combiner connector labeled VHF IN.
- 4) Connect the coaxial cable from the combiner connector labeled **TO TV/CONVERTER BOX** to the "Antenna Input" on the TV/converter box.
- 5) Follow the instructions in your TV owner's manual to change the input from "CABLE" to "ANTENNA", "AIR", or "BROADCAST".
- 6) Point the antennas in the direction of the TV stations' broadcast towers and check for reception by scanning for channels.

**Note:** To locate your broadcast towers, go to [antennapoint.com](http://antennapoint.com) or call your local TV station. You may need to reposition the antenna to receive broadcast signals. Remember to perform a channel scan at every position you try.
